

First Methodist Carrollton Enrichment Teacher Job Description

Overview of Position

The Enrichment Teacher is responsible for nurturing the physical, cognitive, socio-emotional, and spiritual development of children ages two through four years. The successful candidate will demonstrate competence in pedagogy in one of four enrichment specialties (music, movement, STEM, or language/culture) and interpersonal communication skills required for effective working relationships with all First Methodist Carrollton employees.

Responsibilities

- Create a welcoming, caring, and developmentally-appropriate interactive classroom for children ages two, three, and four years; specific to enrichment specialty (music, movement, STEM, or language/culture)
- Develop and implement weekly plans to nurture and stimulate children's growth and development
- Provide responsive care and demonstrate cultural competency when working with all children
- Willingness to comply with First Methodist Carrollton's policies and procedures

Qualifications

- Higher education in enrichment specialty strongly preferred, education in pedagogy preferred
- Minimum of one year childcare experience required
- Demonstrated ability to use child guidance communication skills or willingness to learn
- Ability to effectively plan, organize, and implement educational activities in enrichment specialty
- Ability to lift and carry up to 25 pounds and, in the case of emergency, a 40-pound child
- Demonstrate moral integrity through emotional stability and role modeling for children, families, and coworkers
- Demonstrated work history and excellent references required
- Demonstrated workplace dependability and punctuality required
